

DTEK Grids distributes every third kilowatt-hour of electricity in Ukraine

Ukraine is reforming its energy sector to create an electricity market in line with the European model.

At the first stage of the reform, companies are unbundling generation, distribution, and supply by establishing independent companies for each activity. Distribution system operators have become independent companies which provide equal access to their networks to all electricity suppliers, thereby giving their clients freedom to choose their supplier.

We are working hard to support the reform and have implemented systematic changes across our operations.

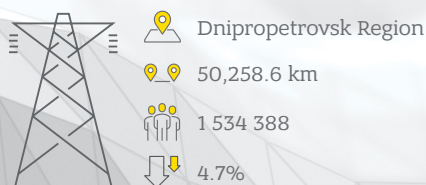
We have unbundled our electricity supply and distribution functions.

DTEK Grids focuses on electricity distribution and is also responsible for reliable electricity supply and development of the power grid. The company has built an effective model - its electricity losses are 5.5%, the lowest in Ukraine. We are constantly upgrading the power grids to integrate modern technologies. These efforts will help meet the needs of Ukraine's cities for automated grid and demand management to improve comfort levels for residents.

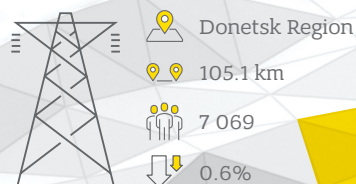

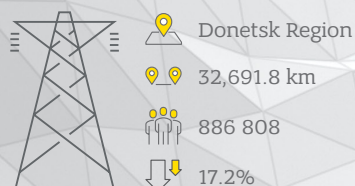

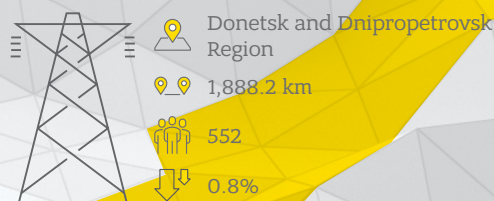

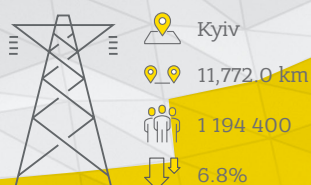
DTEK Donetsk Grids



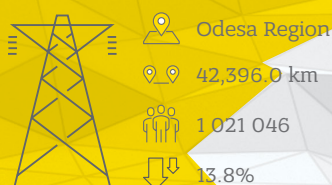
DTEK Power Grid



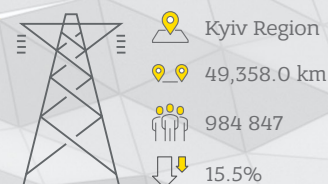
